

**NAPEX 2007 PHILATELIC LITERATURE
EXHIBITION PROSPECTUS AND ENTRY FORM**

1. Philatelic literature includes all printed and electronic publications available to collectors related to postage stamps, postal stationery, postal history, and their collection, and to any associated specialized fields. Entries must be predominantly in the English language. You must submit electronic entries on CD (two copies); NAPEX will not be able to accommodate web site entries.
2. We will accept entries in three categories for the purposes of judging and display, as follows:
 - a. **HANDBOOKS AND SPECIAL STUDIES:** Separate, self-contained treatment of an aspect of a philatelic subject involving research beyond the level of a standard general catalog. NAPEX will place specialized serial publications such as the American Philatelic Congress Book and similar anthologies in this category. This category also includes special studies, specialized articles, specialized catalogs, indexes and bibliographies. NAPEX will accept entries published within the previous three years (Publication date of 2004 or later). You must submit two copies.
 - b. **PHILATELIC PERIODICALS:** Philatelic society journals, newsletters and similar serial publications of individuals or philatelic groups. We will accept entries published within the previous two years (Publication date of 2005 or later); further, the entry must consist of the most recent complete volume or year published. Please submit two copies.
 - c. **NON-COMPETITIVE:** Those editors, authors and societies wishing to have their works displayed, but who do not wish to compete for awards, may submit one copy of their publication. NAPEX will waive entry fees for this category.
3. Authors, editors or publishers may enter a publication. NAPEX will accept revised editions of publications too old for competition only if the revision is sufficiently substantial to constitute a “new” edition. In the case of multi-volume works, the date of each volume shall determine the date of publication for purposes of competition. The APS web site has additional technical guidance on philatelic literature exhibiting for prospective competitors.
4. The fee is \$25.00 per entry. The fee must accompany each entry form. If

you enter more than one item a separate entry form and entry fee is required for each. Make your check payable to NAPEX. Closing date for receipt of all entry forms and fees is March 1, 2007. Mailing address is:

5. NAPEX will notify applicants of acceptance by March 15, 2007. Please send accepted entries to arrive no later than May 1, 2007.
6. A panel of APS accredited judges will act as jury. Decisions of the jury shall be final. An unlimited number of gold, vermeil, silver, silver-bronze and bronze medals will be available to the jury. Additionally, special merit awards may be available for presentation. Exhibitors may request additional certificates (for co-authors, editors, publishers, etc.) for \$5 each.
7. NAPEX will announce awards at the Awards Banquet. NAPEX will present the medal awarded, certificate and Palmares to the exhibitor at the Awards Banquet, or by mail if the exhibitor is not present. The literature jury will have a critique at the exhibition. Following the exhibition, they will send a written jury evaluation for each competitive exhibit to the exhibitor.
8. NAPEX will donate entries to philatelic libraries at the discretion of the exhibition committee, unless the exhibitor specifically requests return and furnishes return postage. All due care will be taken of the items submitted for the literature exhibition, however, no responsibility shall be attached to any society, organization or individual connected with this event in any manner for any loss or damage arising from participation in this exhibition.
